

7:00 → seven <u>o'clock</u> 9:00 → nine <u>o'clock</u>

3:08 → eight <u>past</u> three (8 minutes after 3 O'clock)
4:15 → quarter <u>past</u> four
9:25 → twenty-five <u>past</u> nine
11:30 → half <u>past</u> eleven

8:31 → twenty-nine to nine (29 minutes before 9 O'clock)
0:45 → quarter to one
4:55 → five to five

0:00 → midnight 12:00 → midday / noon

midnight 0:00 noon 12:00 morning: \overrightarrow{AM} (ante meridiem) afternoon / evening: \overrightarrow{PM} (post meridiem) 15h40 \rightarrow 3:40 PM
